### **Community Emergency Response Team**



11-08-2006, The UT Dallas Police Department recognized 57 faculty, staff, and students for completing the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training course. Each graduate who is an active member of the program received a backpack stocked with assorted supplies, an ID card, and certificate. These individuals became the first team of volunteers in UT System to complete the CERT training, and join an elite group of similar university teams across the United States. The team consists of 51 active members, and is ready to respond to a disaster on the campus or in their community to assist first responders if needed. Each graduate is required to complete a disaster simulation once a year and attend multiple training and refresher sessions to maintain their membership. 
