	<i>PAST MASTERS</i> is a collection of primary-source full-text philosophy databases.
	<i>Early Encounters in North America</i> contains pages of letters, diaries, memoirs and accounts of these early encounters.
	<i>North American Immigrant Letters, Diaries and Oral Histories</i> (IMLD) provides a unique and personal view of what it meant to immigrate to America and Canada between 1800 and 1950.
	<i>North American Women's Letters and Diaries</i> contains letters, diaries, and manuscripts written by women from Colonial times to 1950.
