


AES Acceptance Directions

Step 1: The AES acceptance process includes Introduction, Accept Awards, Academic Agreement, and Finish tasks. After reviewing the introduction, select “Mark as Read” and “Next.” You will see your progress illustrated in the Task Details on the left.

Step 2: The second stage of the process is acceptance of your awards within the Financial Aid interface. To review and accept your awards, please select “2018” in the Aid Year column.

Semester Requirements

Academic Year Requirements

I am expected to earn a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better and complete a total of 30 unique UT Dallas credit hours each academic year. I understand that hours repeated for course credit will only be counted once.

If I do not achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better or complete 30 unique UT Dallas credit hours within each academic year in a UT Dallas degree program, my scholarship will be terminated unless I successfully participate in the Summer Academic Progress Initiative.
