This ongoing professional company has served a multi-faceted function as an outlet for creative research into new methods and modes of choreographic development and as a focal point for the sharing and exchange of ideas among its artist-scholar membership. - ARTS 1301 Exploration of the Arts is a core curriculum introduction to the arts lecture course covering dance, theater, music, visual art, film and performance art. Approximately 230 250 general university students enrolled per semester in two sections. Includes "hands-on" workshops in dance, music, drawing, and technical theater. Related duties: supervision of four graduate teaching assistants per semester.
- DANC 1310 Understanding Dance This dance appreciation course is designed to emphasize the history of development of western forms and written analysis of dance works. It includes "hands-on" studio technique sessions and viewing live and video performances.
- DANC 2321 Stretch, Conditioning, Alignment This course is designed to support student growth in dance technique and performance. Floor barre, Pilates, yoga and other practices combine to help students reach individual goals in conditioning strength and flexibility, and to achieve a deeper understanding of these in support of alignment and technique development.
- DANC 2332 Beginning Modern Dance Focus is placed on the fundamentals of alignment and technique. Influence from Cunningham and Humphrey techniques among others.
- DANC 2334 Beginning Ballet Focus on developing basic technique with an emphasis on placement.
- DANC 3333 Intermediate Modern Dance Highest level of technique offered at UTD, serves both intermediate and advanced level students.
- DANC 3342 Dance in Musical Theater This course is designed to combine studio and academic work. Students study the history of American musical theater, and analyze musical theater choreography to identify key elements of design and technique. Students apply findings to their own choreographed work. Technique component includes jazz, ballet and modern dance.
- Dance 3345 Dance Performance This class constitutes the dance ensemble for the University of Texas at Dallas and is open to experienced and upper level dancers. Students entered the class through audition and completed a guest artist residency and subsequent performance.
- DANC 3347 Dance Composition This course develops critical thinking skills, and fosters exploration in choreographic forms and design. Students are guided through a series of creative exercises in which they develop and workshop dance choreography.
- DANC 4317.501 Dance Performance II This class is the advanced performance ensemble for the University of Texas at Dallas. Students are challenged with advanced level choreography and given performance opportunities throughout the semester.
- ATEC 4370.003/DANC 3342.003 Movement for Animators This course explores movement biomechanics from a practical standpoint. Students learn and apply compositional techniques designed to facilitate understanding of movement as a means to communicate ideas and emotions., with an emphasis on application in other creative media.
- HUAS 6340 Studies in Theater and Dance: *Dance as Art: Renaissance into the Twentieth Century* This graduate humanities seminar explores western dance forms through readings, discussion, video viewing and lecture.
