Research Interests

Marilyn Waligore, Professor, Aesthetic Studies / Photography at the University of Texas at Dallas reflects on how our everyday actions relate to global concerns such as sustainability, and questions of scarcity and abundance. She explores connections between photography and sculpture by investigating the object and its materiality, while commenting on the potential for recycling. She employs digital montage to combine photographs of detritus—plastic bottles, steel and aluminum cans, cardboard boxes--into a system, an apparatus, or an invented form. By documenting objects that have a transitory existence, she encourages viewers to reconsider their engagement in daily rituals, and its resulting impact. Inspired by Thomas More's 16th century story of *Utopia*, she believes that a post-industrial society demands an upending of the preference for the new, while challenging notions of how productivity and value are measured. Collectively, the plentitude of our natural resources and the potential of recycled materials, which support our everyday human existence and our place within our environment, are taken for granted. She strives to transform the discarded into the valued, to prompt changes in social behavior. By extension, she reframes the status of the still life genre, historically considered the domain of the woman artist, within contemporary dialogues on the beautiful and the sublime.
