

Occupational and General Safety

Lock-out/Tag out Program: check on safety mechanism related to electrical and steam operations. Only trained personal are to have access to keys/codes to undue safety protection locks.

Statute and/or Policy (Include links to pertinent statute or policy websites):

UTD is subject to the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) requirements concerning worker safety. The lock-out/tag-out is one of the DSHS programs to be established at UTD

Requirements:

EHS is responsible for training of the UTD construction and service workers concerning safety guidelines and best practices

Penalty for Non-Compliance:

Subject to fines, potential for injury or loss of life. Generally restricted to individuals working on specific systems.
