What is the Writing Lab?

The UTD Writing Lab is a valuable resource for UTD Students who want to improve their writing.

The UTD Writing Lab offers individualized tutorial help at no charge. Students may drop in or phone to make a 45-minute appointment with a writing consultant. Together the student and consultant will define goals for the session. You may, for example, work on:

Finding a topic for a paper

Organizing ideas and clarifying thoughts

Drafting and revising papers

Clearing up problems with grammar, punctuation, and English usage

Our consultants are graduate and undergraduate students who have been trained to help students develop strategies to improve their own writing. The help we provide is intended to foster independence. We do not, therefore, guarantee better grades nor do we proofread or edit essays; rather,, we encourage students to take an active part in their own writing process in order to become stronger, more confident writers.

Can You Let My Instructor know that I am visiting the Writing Lab?




