Don't Be a victim!

PROTECT YOURSELF AGAINST

CAMPUS THEFT

FACTS:

- Theft is the most common crime on American college campuses
- Theft is a crime of opportunity; most stolen items were not secured

TIPS:

- Be aware of your surroundings
- Report any suspicious behavior; look out for your community
- Lock your windows, apartment and bedroom doors even if you are home
- Report any broken windows, locks, or doors to Waterview Park
- Secure your bicycles on one of the bike racks. The University Police recommend using a u-shaped lock
- Never leave personal property unattended for any period of time. Examples are laptops, cell phones or MP3 players in common areas.
- Lock your vehicle and put valuable items in trunk
- Keep small, valuable items in a safe or lockbox
- Keep record of your valuable items, including serial numbers to assist with recovery
- Register your bicycles with UPD to assist in recovery
- Engrave your valuable items
- Purchase insurance policies that cover theft
