

FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY

Entire UT Dallas campus fire alarm system is being monitoring 24-7 via a fiber-optic loop connecting to every building fire panel. All 33 buildings have primary reporting to the University Police and secondary reporting to Environmental Health and Safety. 26 of 33 buildings have a Class A reporting loop for redundancy via Simplex Grinnell Fire Alarm Panels. 7 of 33 buildings have a Class B single line reporting structure using Edwards Fire Alarm Panels. Environmental Health and Safety is in charge of 2586 alarm initiating devices at UT Dallas.
