III. UTD ELECTIVE REQUIREMENTS (33 Hours)

Advanced Electives (6 Hours):

All students are required to complete at least six hours of advanced electives outside their major field of study.

These must be either upper-division courses, or lower-division courses that have prerequisites.

Free Electives (27 Hours):

Both lower-division and upper-division courses may be used as electives, but students must complete at least 51 upper-division hours to qualify for graduation.

A MINIMUM OF 120 SEMESTER HOURS IS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION WITH AT LEAST 51 UPPER-DIVISION HOURS.

Note: Core options listed only reflect the courses offered at CCCC. Other courses that may potentially qualify for core requirements must be approved by an academic advisor or the department housing the student's major.
