UT Dallas' Dr. Ross Roeser Named as First Recipient of Lois and Howard Wolf Professorship

Dr. Ross Roeser, a professor of communication sciences in the School of Behavioral and Brain Sciences at The University of Texas at Dallas, recently was appointed to the university's newly created Lois and Howard Wolf Professorship.

UT Dallas Biologist Awarded \$1.6 Million NIH Grant

Santosh D'Mello, a professor in the Molecular and Cell Biology Department at The University of Texas at Dallas, has been awarded a five-year, \$1.63 million research grant from the Institute of Neurological Diseases and Stroke of the National Institutes of Health (NIH). The grant will fund research aimed at understanding how members of a family of proteins called histone deacetylases enhance survival of neurons within the brain.

UT Dallas Geoscientist Stern to Help Lead International Field Conference in Egypt

Dr. Robert J. Stern will help lead an international field conference in the Eastern Desert of Egypt Feb. 17-24. Nineteen scientists from eight countries are expected to participate in the conference, the aim of which is to advance the study of the region's continental crust, known as the Arabian-Nubian Shield, and how it was formed 800 million to 500 million years ago.
