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Partnering with the UTTC

Funding is available through the UT TeleCampus to UT System institutions for course and program development. Course funding approval is a competitive process initiated through a [Request for Proposals](#), which is issued annually and, typically, has two deadlines (Fall and Spring).

The UT TeleCampus is particularly interested in developing programs which meet the needs of the citizens of the state of Texas or the needs of the UT System, have marketability and are collaborative across the UT System. Funding is available for faculty release time for course development and for course production support at the campus level.

Campuses who have received course funding enter into a contractual agreement with the UT TeleCampus and are expected to offer their UT TeleCampus courses each year for a minimum of three years. [Sample Contract](#). Faculty providing courses through the UT TeleCampus retain rights to their intellectual property.

Faculty members who have received course funding are expected to:

- participate in Faculty [training](#) (two all-day sessions, a videoconference and multiple online resources);
- complete the UT System Office of General Counsel's online Copyright Basics course (access will be given before faculty training); and,
- complete and have signed the [Principles of Good Practice Self-Study](#) [129KB] . [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) is needed to view this PDF document.

### Other Course Development Options

UT System faculty members who do not apply for funding or who are not approved for funding are welcome to attend [faculty training](#) and develop courses using the UT TeleCampus course management system. Most of the services available for funded courses are also available for non-funded courses. Credit courses offered through the TeleCampus, whether TeleCampus funded or not, will be added to the campus' annual financial assessment. Non-credit courses also can be developed through a variety of arrangements.
