





### Library Catalog eBook Quick Search

	Oxford Reference Online brings together language and subject reference works from one of the world's biggest reference publishers into a single cross-searchable resource.

	<p><i>North American Immigrant Letters, Diaries and Oral Histories</i> (IMLD) provides a unique and personal view of what it meant to immigrate to America and Canada between 1800 and 1950.</p>
	<p><i>North American Women's Letters and Diaries</i> contains letters, diaries, and manuscripts written by women from Colonial times to 1950.</p>
