

GEOS 7190 (WORKSHOP IN SEISMOLOGY)

(Fall 2005)

This is a seminar format course involving regular progress reports and discussion of current research projects of students, staff, and faculty. Topics include all aspects of seismic research (and related topics including new computing hardware and software and current literature). Active discussion of technical problems and their solution in a group environment is required, as is development of organizational and communication skills. Visitors and outside speakers and video presentations are included as available.

This course is offered every semester. Students are required to lead at least 3 discussions per semester and to actively participate in the rest. Grading is Pass/Fail.
