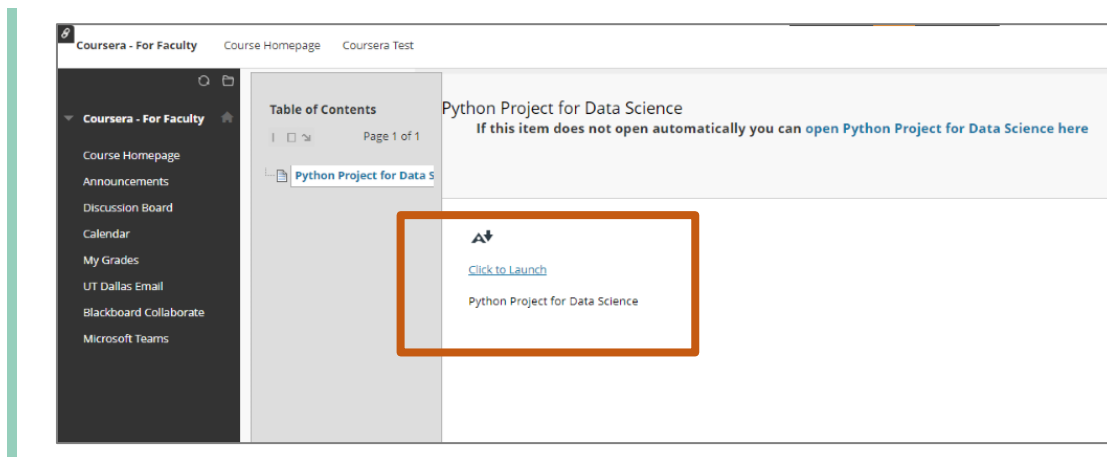


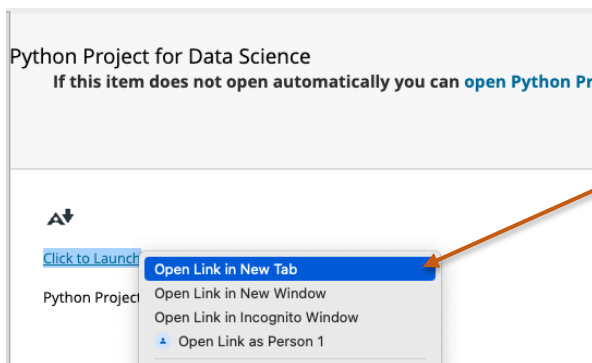
How Students Access Coursera Content in eLearning Courses

How to Access Content for New and Existing Users

1. While in your eLearning course, locate the Coursera Content “**Click to Launch**” link.



2. Right-Click the Link and select “Open Link in New Tab.”

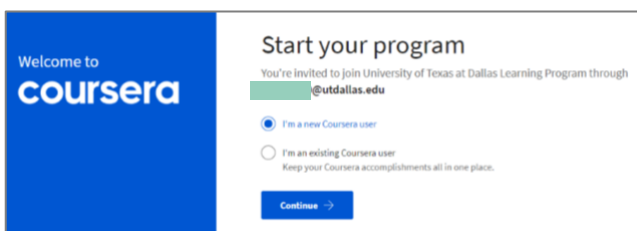


You must use the “Open Link in New Tab” or “New Window.”

If you click the link directly, it will get stuck. If that happens, return to your class, and try the right-click options.

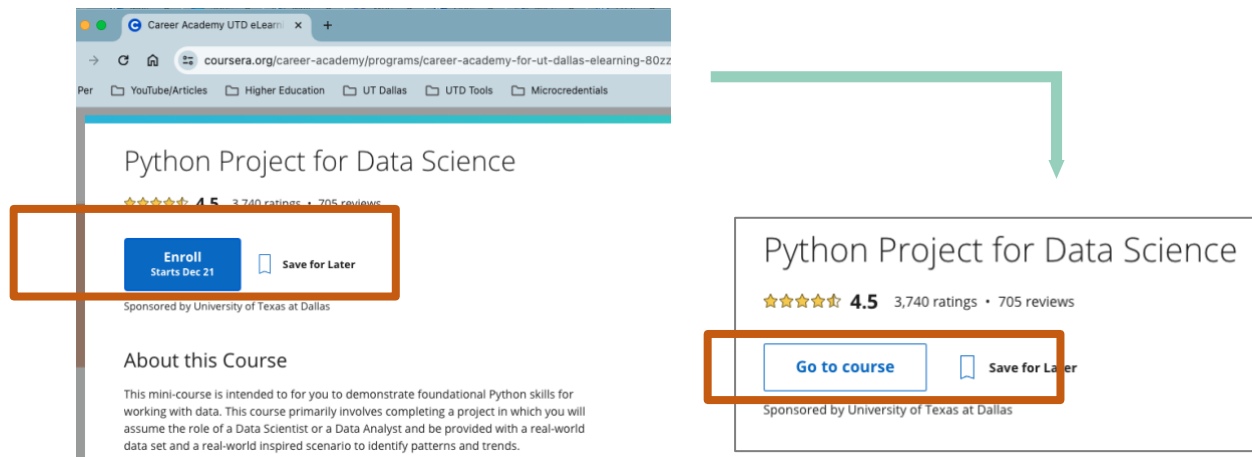
3. Coursera Account Set Up

New Users will select the “New Coursera User” option. Existing Users will have the option to merge their accounts.

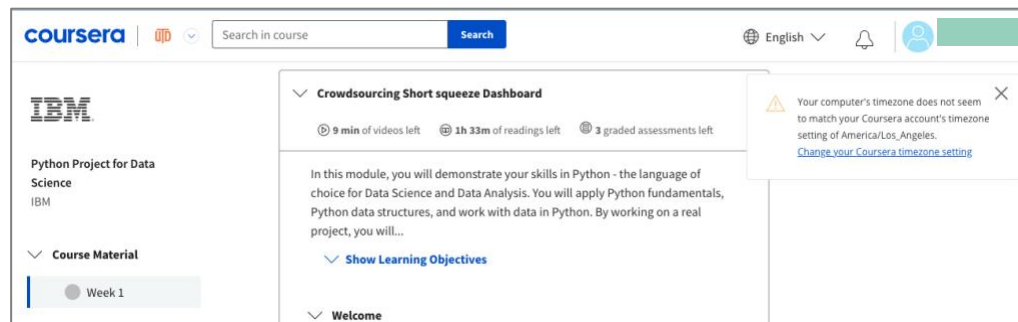


Choose and click **Continue**.

4. Once account set up is complete, a new tab/window will display the Coursera Content page. Click the “**Enroll**” button. After enrollment, click the “**Go To Course**” button.



5. The Coursera content homepage will display. Check with your professor which components you must complete.
