Blackboard Collaborate Ultra™ provides an online environment with chat, audio and video for interactive sharing between desktops or whiteboards for rich media, breakout rooms, and session recordings. Therefore students and instructors can engage as if they were in a traditional classroom.

Preparing for a Blackboard Collaborate Session

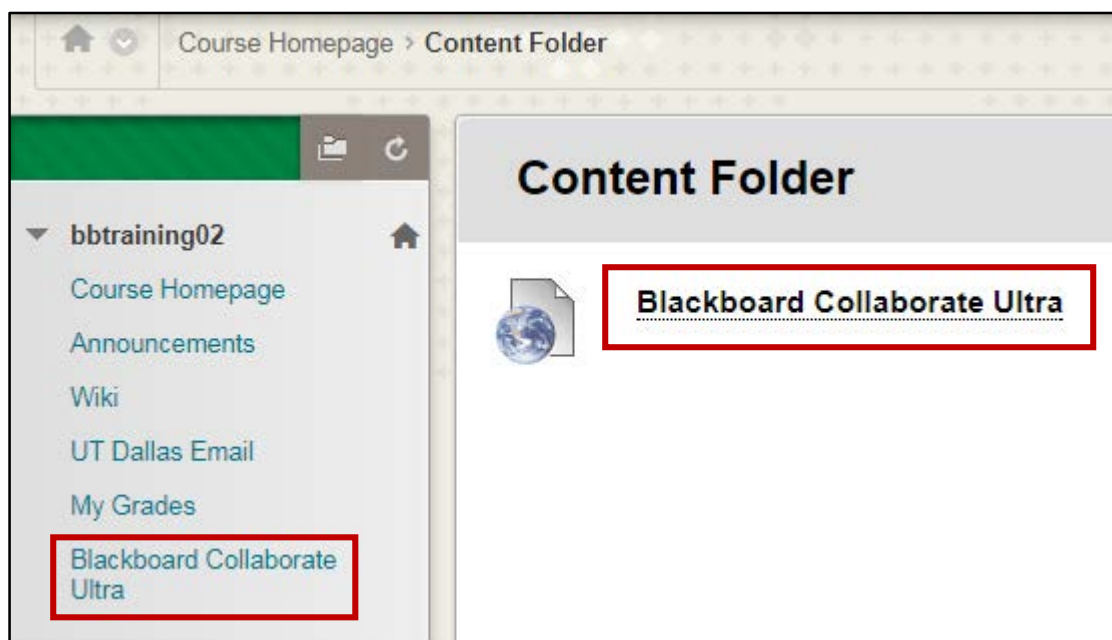
Step 1: Find a comfortable place with no distractions.

Step 2: Be sure to join the session 5 – 10 minutes prior to the start.

Accessing a Blackboard Collaborate Ultra Session

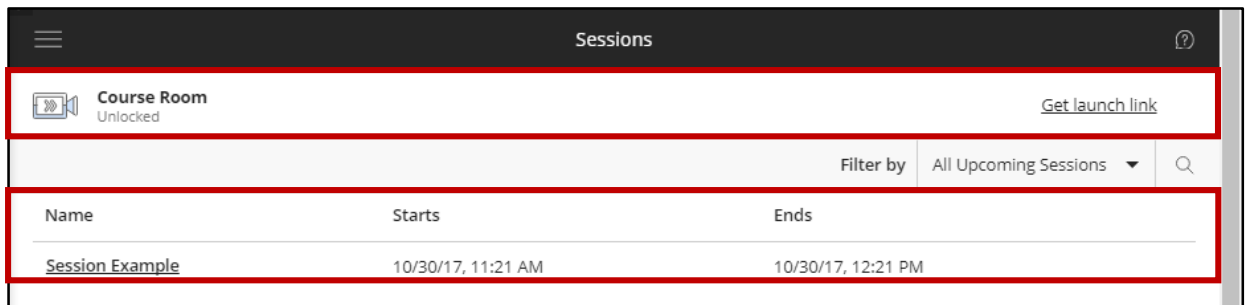
Your instructor can provide access to a **Blackboard Collaborate Ultra** session with a link inside of an eLearning course, an organization, or an e-mail.

Note: The icon for the Collaborate Ultra link may look different.

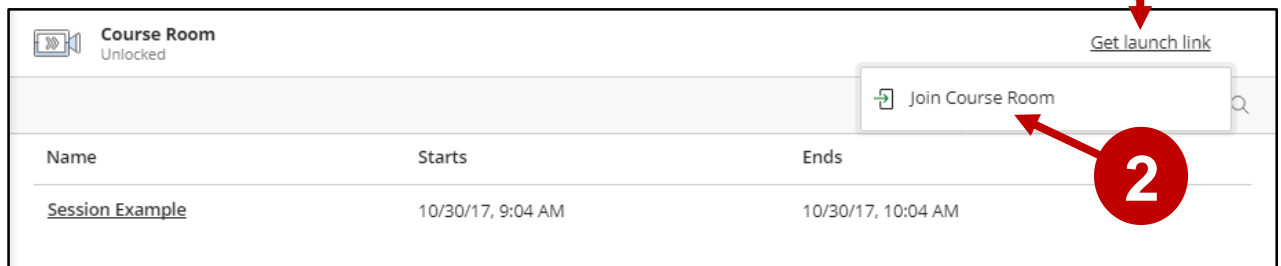

Note: Only active scheduled sessions are underlined.

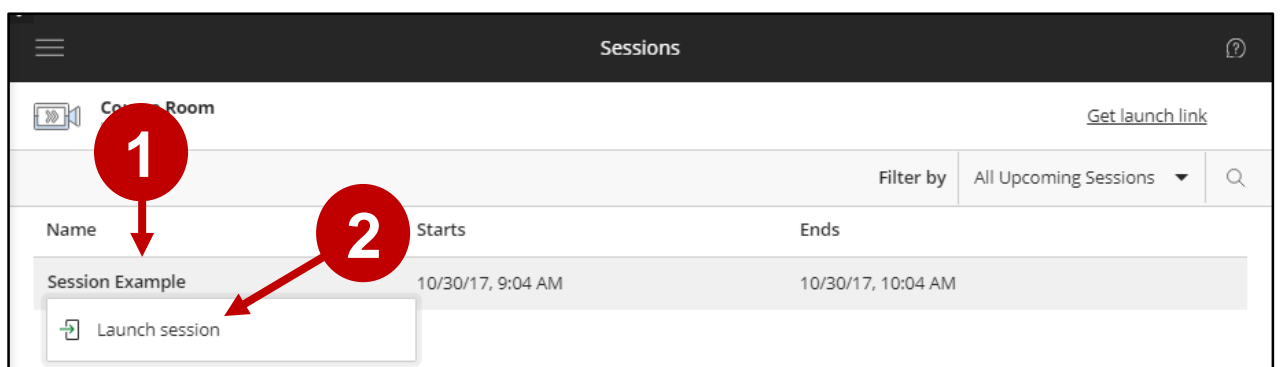
Launching a Course Room

Step 1 and 2: When you click on **Get launch link**, select **Join Course Room**.



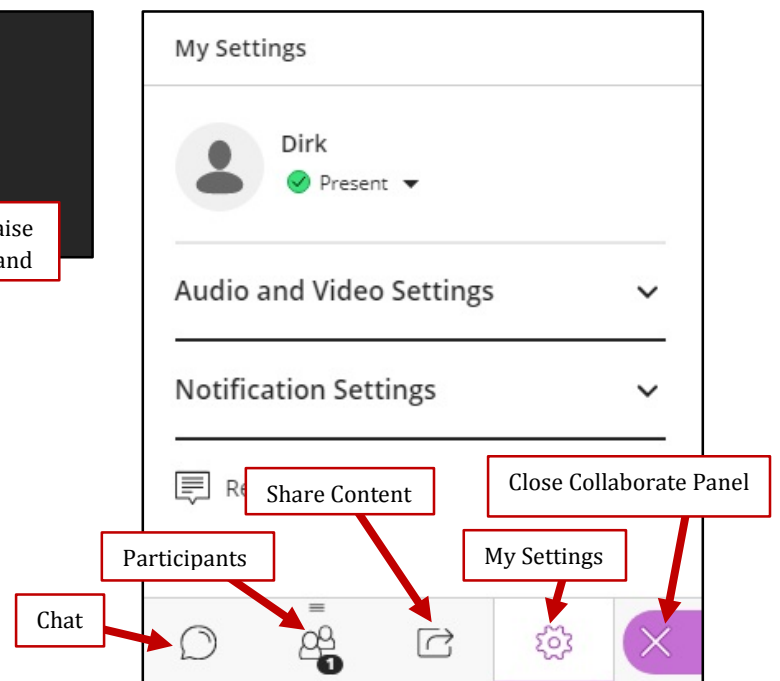
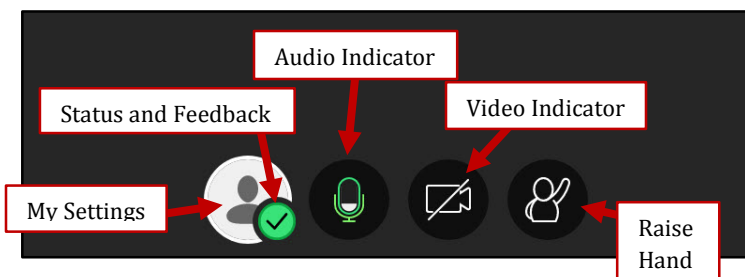
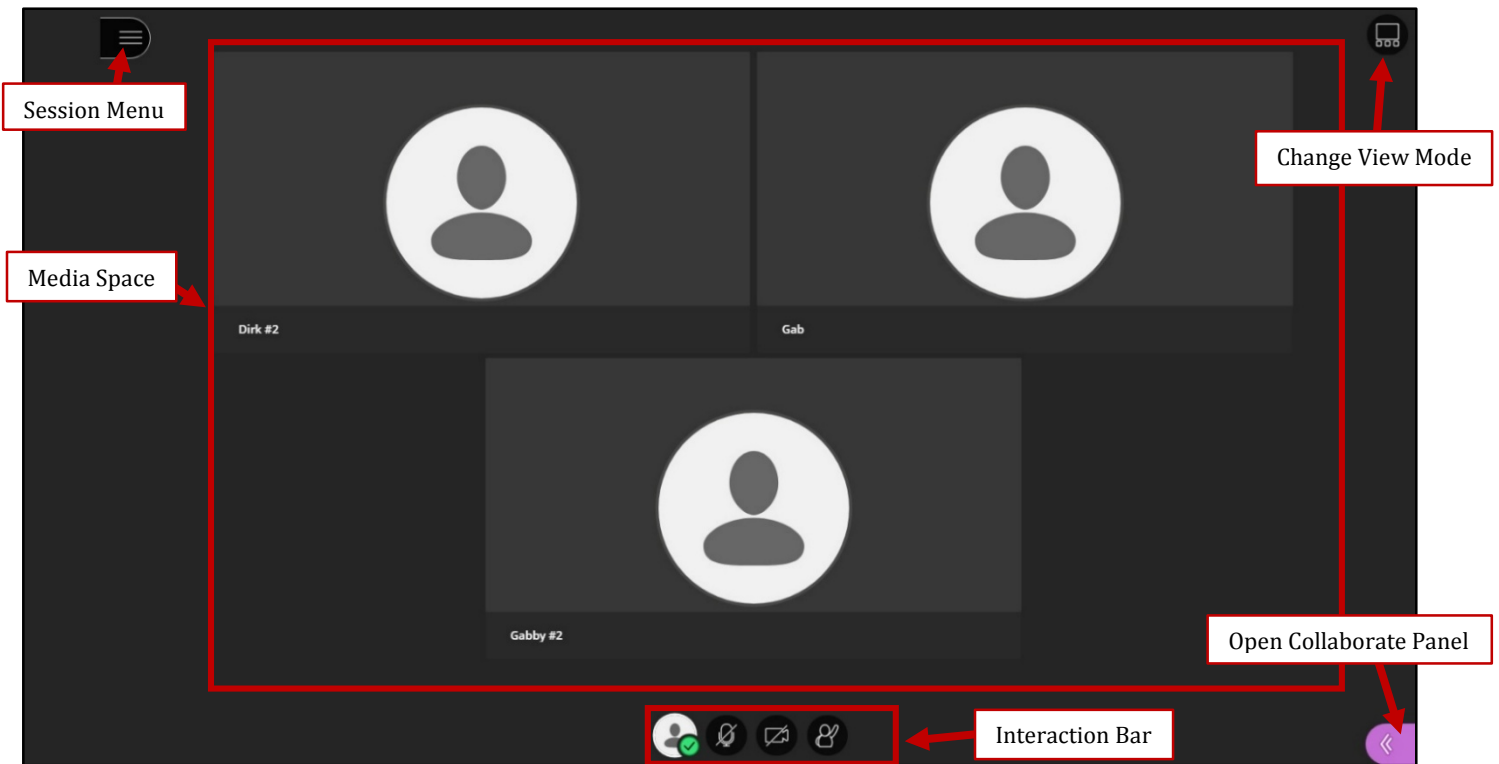
Launching a Scheduled Session

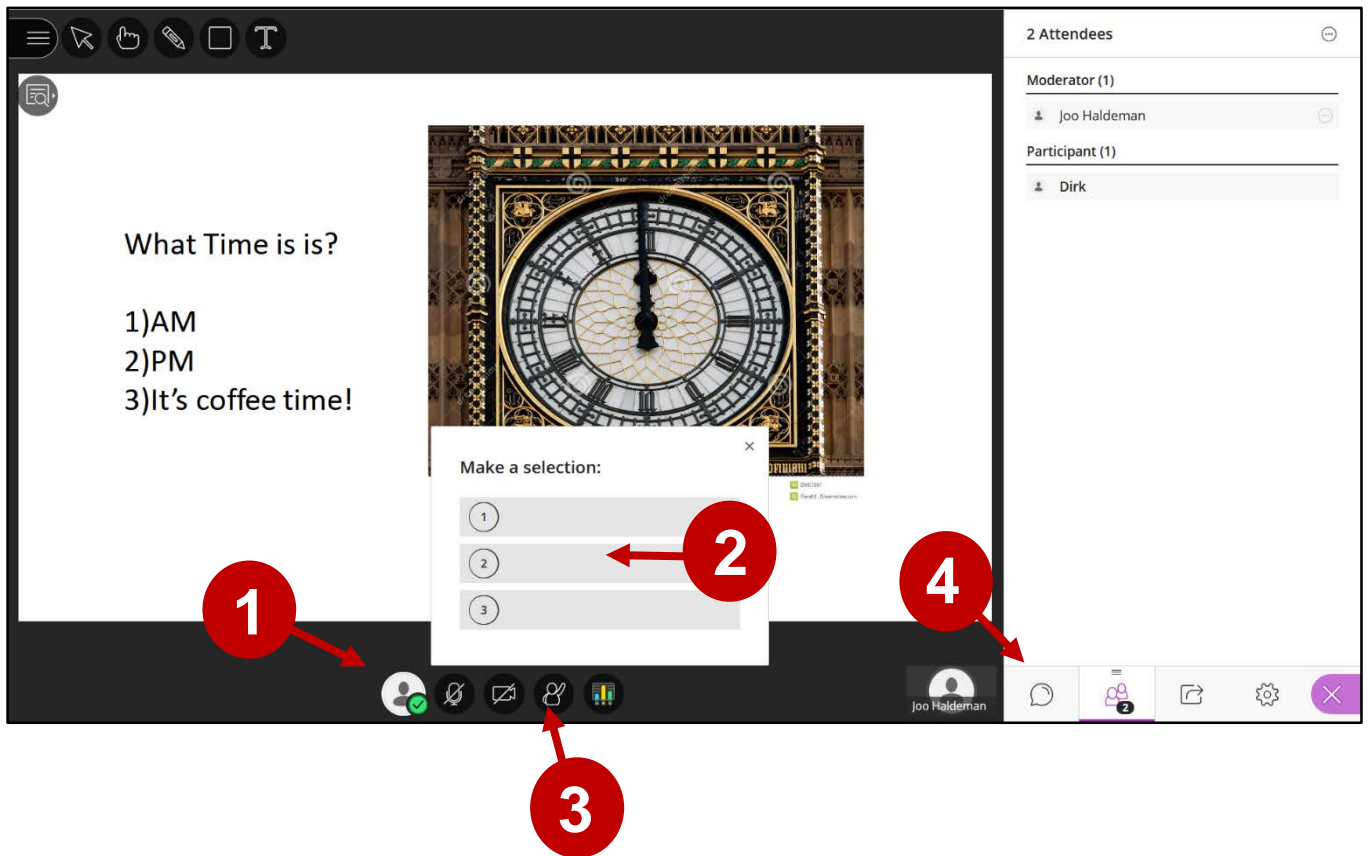
Step 1 and 2: When you click on the session's link, select **Get launch session**.



Note: It is at the instructor's discretion to email a link to participants.

In Session





1. Use **My Settings** to test your microphone and speakers.
2. Participate in the session by responding to **Polls**, providing feedback to the moderator.
3. **Raise Hand** when you have a question or a comment.
4. After selecting **Open Collaborate Menu**, use the **Chat** to send text messages to other participants and the moderator during the session.
