- Graduating senior of a Texas high school or home school
- Acceptance to The University of Texas at Dallas (fall only)
- Strong record of academic achievement
- SAT: 1130 or higher; ACT: 23 or higher
- Exhibit a notable record of leadership and volunteerism
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Texas resident
- Net annual family income of \$100,000 (case-by-case review)
- Submit Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

APPLICATION

The application will be available through the Orion portal (in Galaxy) in early September.

Submit official high school transcript.

Submit two letters of recommendation (at least one from a high school teacher).

Deadline: January 5



OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Apply for on-campus housing (Terry Scholars are required to live on campus the first year).

Total award is over **\$130,000** (encompassing stipend and financial aid, if applicable).
