Collegium V Honors students are able to take advantage of priority registration each semester at UT Dallas. For the Fall 2021 semester, your academic advising office will contact you to begin the registration process. You will receive an email detailing the registration process between April 26th and May 3rd. If you are not registered for classes by May 28th you will be required to wait until July in order to complete class registration.
