Course Description This course is a continuation of Beginning Japanese. It will include review and application of skills in listening comprehension, speaking, reading, and writing. The course emphasizes conversation, vocabulary acquisition, reading, composition, and culture. Includes the study of Japanese culture and civilization.

Learning Outcomes Upon completing this course, students should be able to:

- Participate in conversations in Japanese at an intermediate level.
- Speak about what they are and aren't able to do.
- Utilize giving and receiving verbs with appropriate politeness strategies.
- Understand and utilize casual and polite speech in appropriate settings.
- Demonstrate knowledge of the writing system, including 95 additional kanji characters.
- Utilize strategies for studying and learning Japanese outside of the classroom.
